FUNDRAISING BY OUTSIDE ORGANIZATIONS

Fund raising activities of the Parent Teacher Association (PTA), the Foundation for Public Education, other organizations and charitable activities may be permitted, upon approval of the chief school administrator. However, the chief school administrator shall establish procedures to ensure that funds derived from the fund-raising activities of such organizations are not co-mingled with public funds unless and until a donation is made to the school district.

Any items available for sale within the school building or on school property shall be appropriate for the school.
