

Summer Math Activity Choice Board for students entering Grade 3

Third grade students are being asked to review the math choice board options below and complete a minimum of three boxes. The middle box highlighted in yellow is a required activity. The other two activities can be selected from the remaining boxes in no particular order. If you really want to be challenged, complete as many boxes as you can during summer vacation. Feel free to complete an activity multiple times as repetition reinforces learning.

<p>Write a paragraph explaining how to tell time on a clock.</p>	<p>Write as many coin combinations as you can that equal \$1.00 using nickels, dimes, quarters, and pennies.</p>	<p>Write a script for a TV talk show where two friends have a disagreement caused by regrouping incorrectly.</p> <p>Perform the skit for your family!</p>
