INTRODUCTION

You will be working with two periodicals for this project - print and/or electronic, that focus on a similar topic of your choice. Along with selecting resources and reading articles, you will also be required to complete written assignments.

ASSIGNMENTS

Focusing on one **feature article** from each periodical, you are required to complete the following:

1. A Venn Diagram that you will use to compare and contrast the two articles
2. Reading Response Questions - Two (2) to be answered for each article from a choice board, for a total of four (4) total questions/tasks. These can be written on paper or typed on a Google Doc.
