You will select one of the following two selections to read this summer:

Fish in a Tree by Lynda Mullaly Hunt **or**

Out of My Mind by Sharon Draper

After reading the selection, you will answer one of the following questions, using evidence from the text to support your response. Your thorough and detailed answer can be handwritten or typed.

Question #1

Compare and contrast a character from the story with yourself. In what ways are you similar? How are you different? Be sure to include examples from the story in your explanation.

Question #2

Identify and describe one of the problems / conflicts in this book. Write about a possible solution to the problem. Be sure to include details from the text when explaining the problem and offering a possible solution.

Question #3

What is the author's message to his / her readers? What lesson(s) did you learn from reading this book? Be sure to include information from the book to support your answer.

Question #4

Write the epilogue of this story - 1 year, 10 years, or 20 years after the book ends. Describe what the main character is doing, what s/he has done since the end of the novel, what s/he is like, and what his or her interests are. Be sure to make a connection to the original story.
