The West Long Branch Board of Education considers instruction and experience in the Arts to be a vital part of the total educational plan for each student.

Accordingly, programs in both art and music will be included in the Kindergarten curriculum, and separate curricula will be put in place for grades 1 through 8.

Beyond curricular activities, additional extracurricular programs will be considered in the areas of art, music and drama. Such activities may be in the form of clubs, after school programs, or summer programs. The chief school administrator shall ensure that curriculum in the arts, including both visual and performing, are developed appropriately for each grade level.
